Two initiatives; Koffi Pot, a community coffee shop and Rainbow Arts have been established for many years and have provided the opportunity to build relationships with the wider community. Following on from this and in encouraging and enabling the church community to use their gifts three new initiatives have begun.

Outdoor Church

These are held on four Saturday afternoon during the year, and with one being held jointly with the church family on a Sunday morning in July. We meet in a variety of venues, including a nature reserve, recreation ground, and farm, and we have activities that are linked with a Bible passage. Activities have included model raft making, pond dipping, camp fires, and treasure hunts, and the themes have included: 'Fishing', 'Lost & Found', 'Trust' and 'Light of The World'.
