Romans. 5:1-11.

In 1960 a twelve-year-old had to leave home and live with an aunt and uncle.

An only child, now there were older cousins, was he equally loved and accepted in that home? He was told he had been adopted and no doubt they must have made sacrifices but he kept questioning in his heart: did he really belong? Many years later, on the death of the aunt, he was shown an obituary written by the family: there listed in the immediate family was his name. He belonged!

What is the point of this story? Well, we all seek acceptance. Through who Jesus is and what He did, a Holy God has provided the way we can be accepted by Him. "Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us.
