Devotions for June

Luke 10: 1-10: Jesus sends out the 72.

When Jesus sent out the 72 with the words "the harvest is plentiful but the workers are few", he instructed them to travel light, heal the sick and tell people that the kingdom of God is near. Tucked in there too is the instruction to say "Peace to this house" as an introduction to a household in a new area.

This simple phrase conveys an intent to bless to the stranger, but if the word peace were translated from shalom then it encompasses a sense of wholeness in every area of life. So it is pronouncing in Jesus name wholeness in health, in relationships, in justice, provision, in work; in other words a restoration to God's plan and ways in all aspects of life. If that blessing is accepted then God is freer to act, and His disciples are more ready to allow Him to work through them as instruments of healing and the kingdom of heaven.

Wherever we find ourselves in our daily routines, as disciples we too are sent out, commissioned to restore the kingdom of heaven to earth at every opportunity. If we pray "Shalom to this house" as we knock on familiar and unfamiliar doors alike we bring God's blessing and open ourselves to being used and directed by the Holy Spirit as instruments of His kingdom. *Juli*
